

1. Important Safety Information





Important safety information.

General

The following information and precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of damage, fire, electric shock or injury to people. If in any doubt about installation, operation or maintenance please contact your vendor or Ashton Bentley.

- Follow all warnings and instructions in this document and marked on the equipment.
- · Allow plenty of space in the construction area.
- Never operate the system outdoors or in very humid conditions or allow ingress of any liquid.
- · Always use suitable cable management or install under a raised floor to avoid trip hazards.
- Do not block or cover any ventilation vents in the products.

Displays, Chassis and Tables.

As some parts are large and heavy, we recommend two people assemble. If tethering a Chassis to a wall using the suppled Ashton Bentley Wall Brackets, ensure the wall is solid and stable, and that suitable fixings (not provided) as used.

Recommendations and warnings.

Symbols are used where extra attention is required. For example, if an item is heavy and requires a minimum number of personnel.







Electrical.

If the incoming mains electrical feed is unstable or prone to transient input voltage spikes of more than 1KV, we recommend the use of a surge protector connected to the power input cable.

If any of the following are noticed, then do not use the product until everything is back to a fully safe state:

- Power cables, plugs, power supplies/adapters, extension cords, surge protectors that are broken or damaged.
- · Signs of overheating, smoke, sparks, or fire.
- Signs of liquid ingress or an object has fallen onto the electronic elements of product, the power cable, or power supply/adapter.

Note:

Never wrap a power cable around a power supply/adapter or other object. Always route power cables so that they will not be walked on, tripped over, or pinched by objects.

Do not use any power supply/adapter that shows corrosion at the ac input pins or shows signs of overheating (such as deformed plastic).

The power cable and supply/adapter provided with this product are intended to be used with this product only. Do not use them with any other products. The use of 3rd party power supplies/adaptors will invalidate the warranty.

Do not use your system, or disconnect any cables or perform installation, maintenance, or reconfiguration of this product during an electrical storm.


Product Components.



Product Components


The product is supplied in several cartons. Each carton has a label that contains information about the contents and a Carton ID which can be located as shown below:

Check if any items are heavy and require more personnel.


If using any power tools, follow all safety protocols.

If integrating with any other manufactures products make sure that these are set-up according to the manufacturer's instructions.



Floor to wall chassis (shown with 55" Display)





Chassis with Freestanding Base (shown with 55" Display)


